**ACADEMY PLAYER AND PARENT CONTRACT 2009-2010**

Congratulations on joining Gulf Coast United Soccer Club (GCU) Academy Program for the 2009-2010 Seasonal Year! Our coaches and Board of Directors hope that this will be an enjoyable year for you and your family. As part of the registration process, we want to insure that you are fully aware and understand the commitments GCU makes to you, and what our expectations and obligations from you as a result of you accepting the position offered to you. Please initial the points below acknowledging your understanding of the mutual expectations between you and GCU, then sign and date below.

Academy Registration Fee: Although it is our intent to honor the commitment to play with GCU for the entire seasonal year, we understand that accepting the position offered and completing the registration documents obligates us to pay the full registration fees of **\$330** regardless of whether we later decide to leave GCU prior to the end of the seasonal year. Fees may be paid by credit card and include items such as registration, uniforms, insurance, referee fees, and club overhead expenses. Additionally, we understand that we are required to pay a Training Fee of **\$10 per month per player** to insure all Academy players are getting the fundamental skills needed to compete at the next level.

Upon acceptance to a team, we agree to 1) pay in full (\$330) or 2) provide GCU a non-refundable \$200 deposit and agree to pay the balance (\$130) in full by July 15, Thus fulfilling our financial obligation before the first regular season.

Other Expenses: Additionally, we understand that we are required to share in team expenses above and beyond the club registration fees noted above, to cover entry fees to tournaments that the team decides to participate in, our travel costs associating with attending these events, or other team-based costs. The team may seek and receive donations or fundraise to defray these expenses as well. I understand that all funds collected will be credited to my child’s team account to be used for team expenses. These funds remain with GCU should the player decide to leave the club.

Volunteer Requirements: We understand that as a Member of GCU’s Academy Program, all families are *required* to 1) work in the SJWAA Concession Stand during the course of the season in addition to 2) volunteering at least **five (5) hours on one of GCU’s Committees** (see attached “GCU Volunteer Form”). *This volunteer requirement is mandatory* as it allows the club to provide services to our Member families.

Concession Stand Duty: Concession Stand volunteer hours will be organized by the Concessions Committee and managed by your team’s Team Manager. In general, concession stand volunteer hours will be **2-4 hours per family per team** (in addition to your other volunteer requirement).

Community Service Hours for Bright Futures Scholarships: Senior competitive players will also have an opportunity to earn documented Community Service Hours as part of their State of Florida Bright Futures Scholarships requirements at GCU. (See attached “GCU Community Service Hours Agreement”)

Guest Play Requirements: We agree to abide by the GCU policy of not allowing players to guest play with other teams or members of other teams to guest play with GCU teams, except with the express written approval of the Director of Coaching or his designee. This approval must be accompanied by an authorized “FYSA Guest Player” form. (Note: These exceptions will only be granted if all player’s fees and financial obligations have been fulfilled, and will generally be limited to opportunities that the player would not otherwise be able to participate in, or in unusual circumstances.)

Release Requirements: Should the player wish to be released (other than for season ending injury or a move out of state) or to transfer to another club prior to the end of the 2009-2010 season, the player/parents will be required to 1) fulfill all financial obligations noted above, 2) return all GCU

uniforms & equipment to the club and 3) pay an additional **\$300 per player** processing fee before the "Change of Status" request is processed and the player is released from this contract.

If a Member is expelled from GCU's Academy Soccer Program as result of a violation of the Club's Code of Ethics, the Member family agrees to pay the remainder of its financial obligations to the clubs and agrees to forfeit any fees already paid to the club.

## **FYSA CODE OF ETHICS**

### **PLAYERS:**

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times.
- I will always remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol: and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer training and games.
- I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will concentrate on playing soccer, always giving my best effort.
- I will play by the rules at all times.
- I will at all times control my temper, resisting the temptation to retaliate.
- My conduct during competition towards play of the game and all officials shall be in accordance with appropriate behavior, and in accordance with FIFA'S Laws of The Game, and in adherence to FYSA rules.
- While traveling, I will conduct myself so as to be a credit to myself, and my team.
- A player cannot be cut from a team after he/she is registered to that team, unless he/she has exhibited conduct requiring dismissal, without prior consent from the BOD. If requested by the player and/or parent, a hearing must be held for any involuntary player release.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any time at the field and/or game complex.

### **PARENTS/SPECTATORS:**

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, and administrators at all times.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect.
- I will always be positive.
- I will always allow the coach to be the only coach, by refraining from coaching from the sidelines.
- I will not enter into arguments with the other team's parents, players, or coaches.
- I will not enter the field of play for any reason during the game.
- I will not criticize game officials.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during, after the game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.

Failure to comply may result in the suspension of your privilege to participate in FYSA sanctioned events, for the following periods:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Suspension for a minimum thirty (30) days to a maximum of (5) years.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: Suspension for a minimum of one (1) year to a maximum of ten (10) years.

3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Suspension for a minimum of five (5) years to a maximum of fifty (50) years.

### FYSA ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF REGISTRATION

FYSA RECOMMENDS THAT PLAYERS NOT REGISTER TO A TEAM WHOSE AGE GROUP EXCEEDS THE PLAYERS NORMAL AGE.

**INSURANCE NOTICE:** All injuries must be reported within 90 days of the date of the injury. Benefits satisfied.

**INFORMED CONSENT:** I, the parent/guardian of the registrant, agree that we will abide by the rules of GCU, the state association (FYSA) and all its affiliated organizations. My/our child wishes to participate in soccer during the season of this registration. I/we realize risks are involved in my/our child's participation. I/we understand that the risk to my/our child includes full range of injuries from minor to severe, and the result could be death, paralysis, or other serious, permanent disability. I/we accept this risk as a condition of my/our child's participation.
